Your child needs help learning German and gets a place in a daycare center

Dear Parents,

Your child is expected to start school next year. In order for a child to learn well, it is important that he or she speaks and understands German well.

That's why your child took the PRIMO language test.

This language test is used to check whether a child speaks and understands German well enough to be well prepared for school.

Your child did not score enough on this test. So your child needs help learning German.

What does this mean for your child?

Your child must now attend a daycare center. There your child will be supported in learning German. This will allow your child to prepare well for school.

We have registered your child in three daycare centers in your area. You can find these three daycare centers on the paper in bold letters.

The daycare centers will contact you. You have to sign a contract for your child in a daycare center.
