You have received the official letter in German by mail. This translation helps with understanding.

The name of your child and the names of the three daycare centers appear only in the German letter.

Only the German letter is official and legally valid.

Your child needs help with learning German and will be assigned a daycare (Kita) placement

Dear Parents,

Your child is expected to start school next year. In order for a child to learn well, it is important that they speak and understand German well.

Therefore, your child took part in the PRIMO language test.

This language test checks whether a child speaks and understands German well enough to be well prepared for school.

Your child did not score enough points on this test. This means your child needs help with learning German.

What does this mean for your child?

Your child is now required to attend a daycare center (Kita). There, your child will receive support in learning German. This way, your child can be well prepared for school.

We have registered your child at three daycare centers near you.

The daycare centers will contact you. You must sign a contract for your child at one of the daycare centers.

Does your child already have a daycare spot?

If your child is already attending a daycare center, please inform us.

Further information:

Attending the daycare center is free of charge.

However, if your child stays in the daycare center for 5 hours or longer, they will receive lunch there. The lunch costs 45 euros per month.

If you do not agree:

If you do not agree that your child must attend a daycare center (Kita) due to the test result, you may file a complaint with the Administrative Court of Bremen.

You have one month to do so after receiving this letter.

You can write to the court. Or you can go there in person and state that you do not agree.

LEGAL REMEDY INSTRUCTION
